### **State Parks**

\$7 park entrance fee per day (w/o annual park pass)

Reservations may be made online or phone - recommended

Colorado River - Fruita (To CMU 20 min. 16 miles)

\$28 camping per night with electrical and sewer

\$20 camping per night with electrical only

Colorado River - Island Acres (To CMU 25 min. 20 miles)

\$28 camping per night with electrical and sewer

\$20 camping per night with electrical only

Highline Lake (To CMU 35 min. 25 miles)

\$20 camping per night - no hook-ups

All have showers, picnic tables, fishing, bicycle/walking trails

### **Colorado National Monument**

Saddlehorn Campground (To CMU 35 min. 20 miles)

\$10 park entrance fee (w/o annual park pass)

\$20 camping per night, \$10 seniors camping per night

Reservations may be made online or phone - recommended

Flush toilets, potable water, picnic tables, no showers, no hook-ups

Hiking trails, big horn sheep viewing
